Scholarship Program General Information and Eligibility Requirements

1. The scholarship will be granted to one graduating senior from one of the following schools: Gonzales High School, Shiner High School, Shiner St. Paul, Hallettsville High School, Hallettsville Sacred Heart, Yoakum High School, Moulton High School, Luling High School, Nixon-Smiley High School, and Waelder High School.
2. Each scholarship will be paid at the rate of \$500.00 per fall and \$500.00 per spring semesters (with a maximum of two semesters per year) for a total up to ten semesters. The recipient must be enrolled as a full-time (at least 12 semester hours) student in an accredited university and must attend continuously with a break of no more than summer semesters. A student who allows his/her grade point average in college to drop below 2.9 out of a 4.0 or is placed on academic or disciplinary probation or suspension forfeits any future scholarship payments.
3. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who has demonstrated an interest in seeking a degree in civil engineering.
4. Each applicant will complete an Application form.
5. All applicants will write a one page essay explaining why he/she wishes to obtain a degree in civil engineering.
6. Applicant must be a US Citizen
7. Applicant must have a minimum high school grade point average of 3.5 on a four-point scale.
8. Applicant must be accepted in an accredited university as a full-time student (minimum 12 semester hours) and enrolled in courses leading to a baccalaureate degree in civil engineering.
