3. Applicant must have a minimum high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher depending on the school's weighting practice of GPA.

Requirements of Recipient

1. Recipient of Scholarship will continue to receive this opportunity providing they:
 - stay enrolled at an accredited university as a full time student (12 semester hours) and without a leave between semesters (outside of summer break)
 - remain a civil or environmental engineering student for the duration of the degree (changing majors forfeits scholarship)
 - are obtaining a bachelors degree at a minimum and hold a grade point average of 2.9 or higher
 - do not get placed on academic/disciplinary probation or suspension
